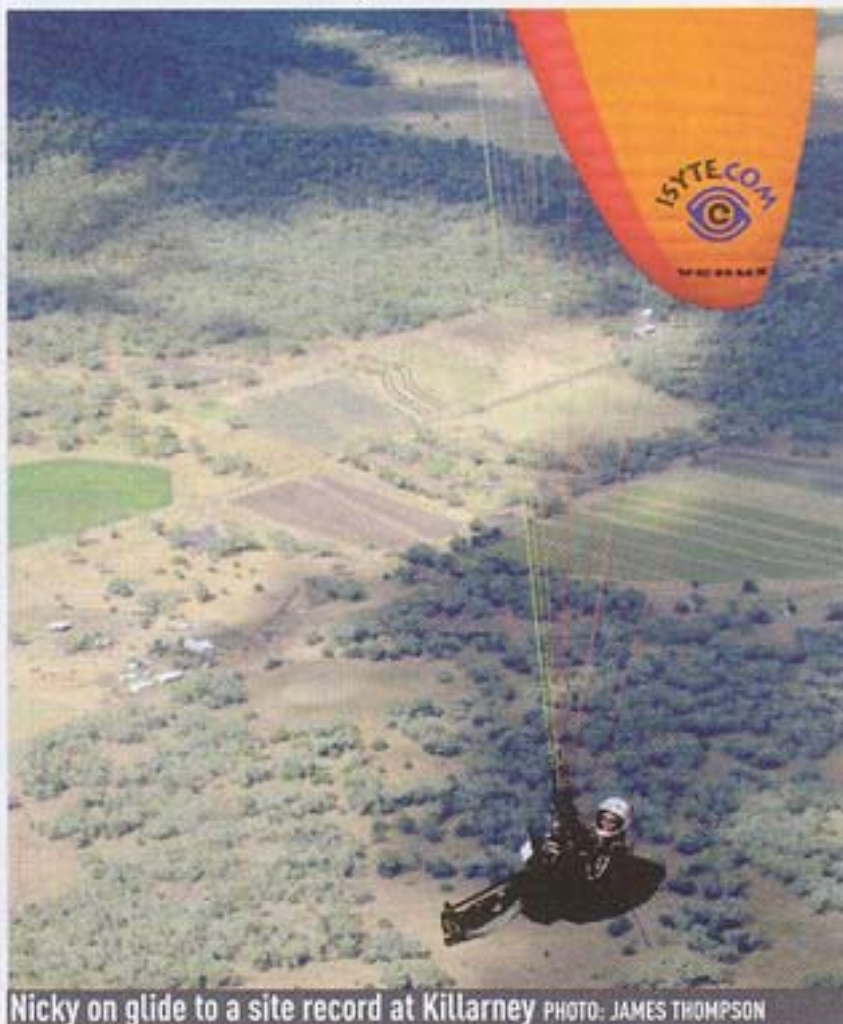


## Nicky sets site record

During the Killarney Classic in January in Queensland, Australia, British team member Nicky Moss flew her new Axispara Venus to a site record of 103km. From a 20km final glide, Nicky crossed the goal line at Pittsworth (92km) in two hours 45 minutes while still at cloudbase, and continued gliding until forced to land by an airspace boundary. Nicky reported that without this restriction the day would easily have allowed 150 - 180km, and is sure her record will soon be broken. Killarney, on the western edge of the Great Dividing Range, has been developed by Andrew Horchner and is known by some as the 'New Manilla'.
